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ARMY PUBLIC SCHOOL SCHEME

1. Salient features

Army Public schools had their origin in 1983 to impart quality education upto secondary school and senior School certificate level to children of Army personnel at a reasonable cost. The schools are run by the Army Welfare Education Society (AWES) under the aegis of Adjutant General's Branch. These schools are affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) New Delhi.

Army Public Schools are run on the lines of Kendriya Vidyalayas. Admission to Army children is guaranteed in these schools.

2. Scope

- (a) Army Public schools are co-educational and prepare students for 10+2 Scheme.
- (b) Syllabus as per CBSE New Delhi is adopted.
- (c) Medium of instruction is English.
- (d) Combination of subjects at senior secondary level:-

Science stream Subjects:-

English, Maths, Physics, Chemistry, Biology/ Computer Science.

Commerce stream Subjects:-

English, Business Studies, Economics,
Informatics Practice/Maths, Accountancy

3. Admission

1. Priority

- (a) Children of serving Army Personnel, DSC personnel,
Army war widows, Assam Rifles and TA (When Embodied)
- (b) Children of Ex-servicemen and Ex-DSC men,
- (c) Children of serving Air Force and Naval personnel,

- (d) Children of Ex-Naval/Air Force personnel,
 - (e) Children of Civilians paid out of Defence Estimate, MES, etc.
 - (f) Other Children subject to availability of vacancies
- (II) Fresh admission to Army Public School will be through admission test.
- (III) All necessary documents like Progress report, Transfer Certificate from the previous school, original birth certificate are to be attached with the Admission Form. The Transfer Certificate is to be countersigned by the District Education Officer if it is a case of Inter- state transfer and if the student is not from an Army Public School.
- (IV) Admission of new students to various classes in the school shall be made from the first week of April and shall be finalised by the month of July.
- (V) Admission test will be conducted by the school on the dates notified by the Principal.
- (VI) Admission will be allowed after a student qualifies himself/herself in the test and submits the T.C. of the previous school along with the progress report of the last examination passed.
- (VII) Admission without Transfer certificate shall be made only upto Class IV. If a pupil who has not previously attended any recognised school, applies for admission to any of the Classes II to IV, his/her parent/guardian shall be required to give full history of previous education and submit an affidavit to the effect that the ward has not attended any recognised school till then. He shall also have to submit an affidavit recording exact date of birth of the ward. If any of the above information is found to contain misrepresentation of the facts, the

Principal shall have the power to cancel the admission.

(VIII) The admission test shall be held in the following subjects.

Classes I to V- English, Hindi and Mathematics.

Classes VI to X- English, Hindi, Maths, Science

Classes X&XII - Applications accepted only from CBSE Stream

(IX) The Principal's decision will be final.

(X) The student should complete the age of 5 years on 31st March of the year for admission to class 1, but he/ she should not be more than 7 years. The age for admission to other classes will be regulated accordingly.

1. Parents can meet the principal between 2.00 PM and 3.00 PM on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday and at any other time during working hours with prior appointment.
2. On working days parents can meet the teachers only after school hours.
3. Last working day of every month will be a half day (upto 10.30 AM) and there will be Parent Teachers Meeting for academic updation from 11.30 AM to 12.30 AM (class will be announced on monthly basis)

- (f) Student coming late or in improper uniform will be punished or marked absent and sent back home.

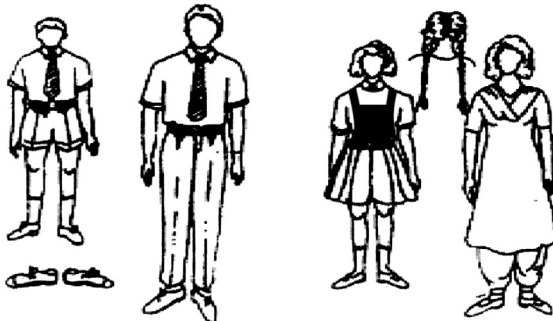
SCHOOL UNIFORM

BOYS

- (a) Steel grey shorts upto V, trousers from class VI up wards.
White shirt with half sleeves.
- (b) Black shoes with lace, Steel grey socks.
- (c) School belt (Red and blue stripes) with school badge.
- (d) School tie (Red and blue stripes)

GIRLS

- (a) White Shirt with half sleeves with tie collar and red ribbons for hair.
- (b) Steel grey skirt with Tunic (Square neck) upto X and steel grey kamez with "Square" neck white salwar & white Duppatta for XI & XII.
- (c) Black shoes, Steel Grey socks, School Belt, Tie & Badge.
- (d) On Wednesdays PT Dress (White & White) with White PT shoes and White Socks.
- (e) On Fridays House coloured Shirt with white Shorts/Trousers and white PT Shoes and white socks.



ATTENDANCE

1. A pupil will be eligible to appear in the Session Ending Examination if he/she has completed 75% attendance.
2. Leave to a student for absence is granted only on an application (leave letter) addressed to the Principal through Class Teacher submitted on time (definitely the same day, rarely the next day in unavoidable circumstances) duly signed by the parent/guardian, if parent is not with the student.
3. The period of leave with reasons should also be recorded in the student's calender by the parent with signature.
4. In case of illness, a Medical Certificate must be attached with the application. Long absence except in case of illness is discouraged.
5. The name of the student will be struck off from the rolls of the school if he/ she is absent for more than a week continuously without a sanction of leave.

LIBRARY RULES

1. All students of the school are members of the library.
2. Strict discipline and silence will be observed in the library and reading room.
3. A student can borrow one book at a time.
4. Library books can be issued and returned during library period of the classes only and not in the teaching period.
5. Library books should be properly looked after and deposited on the due date.
6. Marking, underlining, cutting and erasing or tearing pages of the books are strictly prohibited and liable to be punished if any such damage to the library books is detected by the librarian.

7. Text books, reference books, journals and periodicals are to be read in the library and reading room only and those are not meant for home issue.
8. The librarian may recall a book at any time in case of urgency.
9. Library books are to be deposited at least one week before leaving the station or any break and one month before any vacation.
10. A ' No Due Certificate' is to be obtained from the Librarian and submitted to admin. office while withdrawing any student from the school.

HOW TO CONDUCT AS AN ARMY PUBLIC SCHOOL STUDENT

1. Remember - Language for communication in the school is English.
2. Be a regular scholar. Come to school in clean and tidy school uniform.
3. Let there be grace and sense of pride and purpose in your work and movement.
4. Be regular in moving to the assembly. Be quiet and take an active part in its conduct.
5. Extend your help in keeping the class-room and the school campus clean. Don't scatter bits of paper on the floor. If you find any, remove them. Neither disfigure the walls nor damage the school furniture and other properties. They are yours and you have to pass them on to younger brothers and sisters. Report any damage or loss immediately to the Class - teacher or Principal. Any damage will be made good by the person responsible.
6. Don't loiter about outside the classroom while the school is in session.

7. While moving from one class to another take care not to disturb other classes. Always move in a line.
8. Bring only the prescribed text books and note books.
9. Take care of your things. Don't lose them.
10. If you find anything belonging to school or any other student, deposit it in the office.
11. While going out of the class when the school is in session, take Class - Pass.
12. Read Newspapers and Magazines regularly. Don't mark, underline or annotate them.
13. Don't do anything that is derogatory to your self respect.
14. Your work and conduct should be such that it should bring a good name to the school. That will open a bright future to you.
15. Carry out the instructions of Class Leader, House Captains and School Captain.
16. Be an active participant in every school activity.
17. Enter Home - assignments in your school diary regularly and do the work regularly.
18. Follow up the corrections & suggestions of the teachers.

 - (IV) Spending quality time with your ward.
 - (V) Depositing fee as per rules.
 - (VI) Providing proper school uniform daily.
2. Please look into your ward's school diary frequently and see to it that the assigned home- work is done regularly.
3. Please see and countersign the remarks made in the school diary regularly.
4. If you feel or notice that your ward is not making the desired progress, kindly see the Principal. You are always welcome to the school to assure the progress of your ward.
5. You may contact the subject and class- teachers personally in the respective classrooms on the last working day of every month after 11.00hrs.

No other day is allowed for this purpose. You can visit the Principal on the same day if required.
6. Please ensure that your ward comes regularly to school in neat, clean and tidy school uniform. Don't force the authority for exemption.
7. Please **DO NOT** send your ward to school when he / she is suffering from an infectious disease. Intimate the school about the illness.

8. Please don't give costly things or extra money to your ward.
9. Please ensure that your ward is escorted safely to the school and back home.
10. Private tuitions by the school teachers are strictly banned. Please don't request for the same.
